

Dancing star.

Materials and equipment

Dancing star templates

Scissors

Coloured card

2 Pipe cleaners

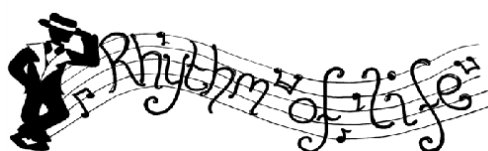
1.5m ribbon (3cm wide)

Sticky tape

Double sided tape or glue stick

Pens etc to decorate

Children must be supervised by
an adult for this craft activity





To make a dancing star

- 1 Using star templates draw 1 large star and 2 small stars on coloured card.
- 2 Cut out the stars and put to one side.
- 3 Take the 2 pipe cleaners, hold the two together at one end and twist them around each other.
- 4 Fold the twisted pipe cleaners in half and twist around each other again. This is your handle.
- 5 Attach the handle to one side of the large star with sticky tape.
- 6 Using glue stick or double sided tape stick one of the small stars to the large star over the pipe cleaner handle to hide the joint.
- 7 Attach one end of the ribbon to the other side of the large star with sticky tape and cover this join up with the remaining small star as in point 6.
- 8 Decorate the card stars as desired with pens etc.
- 9 Dance at carnival with dancing star.
