Materials and equipment

Wobbly star hat templates

Scissors

Pencil

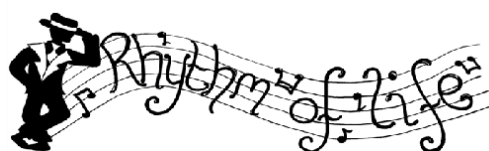
Pens etc to decorate

6 pipe cleaners

Sticky tape

Glitter optional

Children must be supervised by
an adult for this craft activity

To make the hat band

- 1 Either draw around part 1 of hat template on coloured card twice and cut out OR measure 2 strips 4cm wide along the long edge of an A4 piece of card. You can then just cut out two straight bands of card or customize to your own shape e.g. with wobbly or spiky edges etc.
- 2 Put the two pieces end to end and join with tape
- 3 Decorate one side of this band with bits of card, pens, glitter etc as desired.
- 4 Hold the decorated band around your head and tape the remaining two ends together to fit your head. Put band to one side.

To make wobbly stars

- 5 Take a pipe cleaner and wrap it around a pencil. Gently remove the pencil from the pipe cleaner spiral and put to one side. Repeat with remaining 5 pipe cleaners.
- 6 Attach one end of each pipe cleaner to the inside edge of the hat band using sticky tape. Space the pipe cleaners evenly around the band.
- 7 Either draw around the star template 2 on coloured card 6 times and cut out, OR draw your own shapes to wobble and cut out.
- 8 Decorate the stars or shapes as you wish.
- 9 Attach one star or shape to each of the exposed pipe cleaner ends with tape.
- 10 Wear your hat to the carnival.
